



FOURTH GRADE Learning Objectives for **Foreign Language**



Students choose between French and Spanish. The emphasis at this stage is on exposure to the language and an increase in general language awareness, as well as offering an insight into the cultures of the countries where the foreign language is spoken. Activities will be mainly oral, but basic reading and writing skills may be practiced.

LISTENING

The learner will

- understand simple classroom commands.
- understand short statements and familiar questions.

SPEAKING

The learner will

- offer brief responses to what he/she sees and hears.
- identify single items of vocabulary.
- respond to familiar statements and questions with some prompting.
- speak with approximate pronunciation.

READING

The learner will

- understand single items of vocabulary presented in a familiar context.

WRITING

The learner will

- copy single familiar words correctly.
- label items.
- select appropriate words to complete familiar phrases and sentences.
