



A.I.S.C.T. Uniform Policy

2008 – 2009 Academic Year – updated 5 August 2008



The AISCT uniform exists for the benefit of our students and the larger learning environment. It is expected that the following policy be adhered to by all students.

- I. It is expected that uniform items be purchased from the uniform shop. Any item not purchased from the school supplier will be subject to review by the AISCT school administration.
- II. It is expected that students wear the light blue school issued button-down shirt (with buttons done up), beige trousers/ shorts/ skirts and, when necessary, the school fleece jacket or crewneck pullover.
 - A. Elementary students in Pre-Kindergarten to Grade 5 must also wear school-provided trousers, shorts, skirts, or pinafores from the uniform shop.
 - B. Students in Grades 6 to 12 must purchase trousers, skirts, or shorts from the uniform shop OR wear a store-bought equivalent to those sold by the school supplier. Store-bought trousers, shorts, or skirts must be plain beige and free of logos, patterns, cargo pockets and/or other decorative features, and be of a like material to those items sold by the school.
 - C. Non-school issued shirts, jackets, sweaters, jumpers, or other “top-wear” is not permitted.
 - D. Student skirts and shorts must be an appropriate length (just above the knee).
 - E. Comfortable footwear is required. Trainers, tackies, and running shoes are acceptable. Any shoes/boots/ sandals must be pattern free and of a neutral color (such as black, brown, white, navy blue, or beige). Flip flops or other shoes with no back are not permitted.
 - F. Any tights/stockings/leggings must be skin tone, navy blue, or black and pattern free.
 - G. Male students in Grades 6 – 12 are required to wear a belt. All belts must be plain black or brown.
 - H. Any cultural headscarves, headbands, or other hair accessories must be pattern free and in school colors (navy blue or beige). It is not permitted to wear caps or hats inside the school building.
 - I. Grade 12 students are permitted to wear the “Senior” shirt, but all other items must be school issued or in line with the school uniform policy.
 - J. Any short sleeved undershirts worn underneath the blue button down uniform shirt can be white or navy blue.
 - K. Any long sleeved undershirts worn underneath the blue button down uniform shirt must be navy blue.
 - L. The Physical Education uniform includes a navy blue shirt, navy blue shorts, and optional track pants and “hoodie” sweatshirt, all available in the uniform shop. Students are expected to be in the school-issued P.E. shirt and navy shorts for all P.E. sessions.
- III. Other
 - A. Elaborate jewellery is not necessary for school. Any necklaces, earrings, bracelets, rings or other accessories should be small in size and cause no risk of injury to the wearer or fellow students.
 - B. Any issues pertaining to uniform and not detailed in this policy are left to the discretion of the school administration.
 - C. Any uniform policy infringements will be dealt with immediately. In the result that the school is unable to temporarily loan the required uniform item to the student, the student may be removed from class until appropriate uniform items are brought from home.
